S#5 Episode #2 Can Children Hear the Voice of God?



God speaks to us but do we hear him? Learning to hear His voice is something we all should do. In "A Discipleship Journey Kids," we learn that you are never too young to hear the voice of God.

There are four voices we hear:

- 1) Our own thoughts and experiences
- 2) The opinions of others
- 3) The devil's influence
- 4) The voice of God

Some of the ways God speaks:

1) Through the Scriptures – Psalm 119:105, Joshua 1:8

2) Through Waiting on God – Luke 6:12-16 (prayer), Acts 13:3-2 (worship, fasting)

- 3) Through the Holy Spirit's Impressions Acts 8:26-40. Acts 16:6-10
- 4) Through Peace Colossians 3:15

5) Through Circumstances – open and closed doors (Acts 16:6-10)

6) Through Other People – parents, family members, pastor, Sunday school teacher, coach, teachers, other friends of Jesus

7) Through Supernatural Means – visions and dreams (Matthew 2:13-25), whatever means God chooses (for example, Numbers 22:21-35)

Help Your Child Discern:

Does it match up with what the Bible says?

Does it line up with God's character and ways?

Does it shine a light on Jesus?

Do you know it's right in your heart?
