Season 6 Theme - God: Misrepresented and Misunderstood

It's been a little over a month since the shooting in Nashville where six people were killed. We know we live in a world of injustice, but something like this often leaves us wondering where is God's justice?

Definition - Dr. Tim Keller who has a wonderful understanding of this area of justice. He says that justice Scripturally has three components to it. As we look at these components, note that they express God's heart and His perspective of justice. First, in legal terms, justice is the acquittal and punishment of every person based on the same standard regardless of race or social status. Secondly, justice has to do with each person receiving what is rightfully due or owed him. And thirdly, justice has to do with a generous concern to the unfortunate four of the scripture—the widow, the orphan, the immigrant, and the poor; people who are in need and have lost things. This is important for us to understand, justice doesn't just have to do with getting what's right or receiving due punishment. Justice also has a generous concern for those in need.

Scripture References

Psalm 89:14 - Righteousness and justice are the foundation of your throne.

Psalm 103:6 - The LORD works righteousness and justice for all the oppressed.

Isaiah 61:8 - “For I, the LORD, love justice; I hate robbery and wrongdoing. In my faithfulness I will reward my people and make an everlasting covenant with them.

John 5:28-30
